A properly performed scalp double cleanse may help remove:

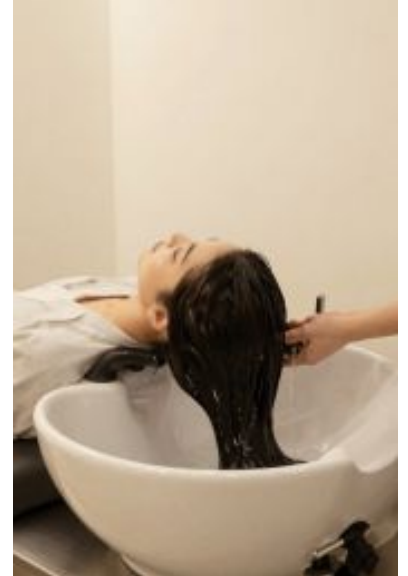
- sebum oxidation,

Over-cleansing, harsh products, environmental exposure, stress, and heat styling may gradually weaken this protective function.

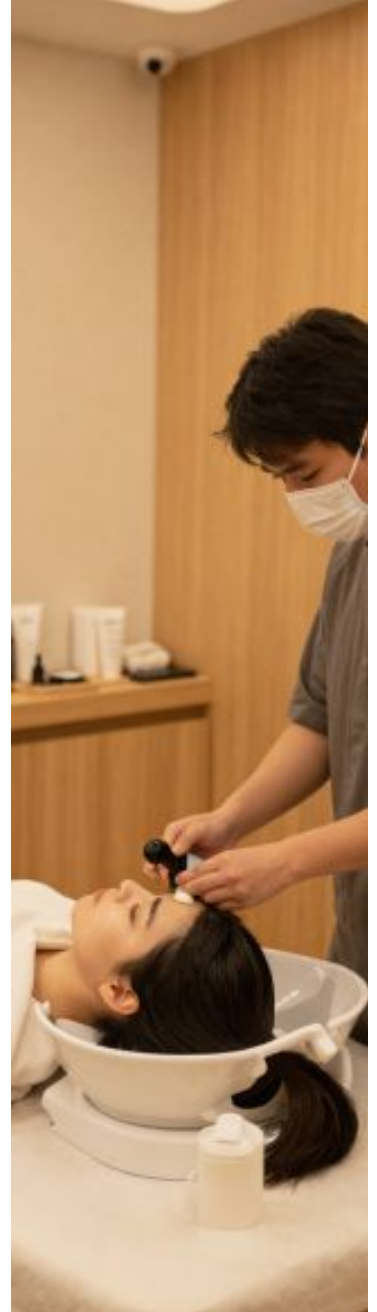
When the scalp barrier becomes compromised, symptoms may include:
